







DIG SAFE

The new Vermont Dig Safe state law requires that anyone who excavates within an underground utility easement or the area of a public right of way must notify utility companies at least 48 hours before digging. The utilities in Vermont which supply gas, electricity, telephone service, and cable television have many miles of underground facilities. In order to protect these underground facilities and meet the requirements of the law, the utilities have established a Public Utility Underground Facility Damage Prevention System called "DIG SAFE." One free phone call to the Center satisfies the law as all member utilities will be notified prior to the start of digging. So, call "DIG SAFE" before you dig-
